SEARCH CAREFULLY- SOME WORDS ARE BACKWARDS OR DIAGONAL.

BALLHOOTER: One who rolls or slides logs down a hillside.

BARKER: The person who peels the bark off a tree with a spud; a peeler.

BLACK LEAD: Coffee

BULL OF THE WOODS: Camp Boss

BULLWHACKER: A logger who guides the teams of bulls pulling logs

CATFACE: Fire scar on a tree

CLEARCUT: An area where all of the trees have been harvested at the same time.

CIGAR RAFT: An oceangoing, submarine-shaped bundle of logs headed for the mill; some measured 1,000 ft. in length and contained as much as 6 million board feet of timber.

DONKEY: A steam engine that used powered winches to pull large logs.

DOORKNOBS: Biscuits

FOREST: A large area of tree

MURPHIES: Fried Potatoes

LUMBERJACK: An individual who worked in the woods during a logging process; a Shanty man or boy.

RIVER RAT: The person who floats the logs down the river to the lumber mill.

SECOND GROWTH: A general term for trees that have grown back since previous logging.

SINKERS: Doughnuts

SPRINGBOARD: A wooden plank to stand on while cutting the tree down.

STAG: Cut off trousers, knee or boot height, that won't get caught on brush, limbs, or tools.

STUMP: Base of tree left after cutting.

SWAMPER: Person who cuts the branches off of a tree after it has been cut down.

TRESTLE: A braced framework of timbers or logs, called piles, that bridge a river or ravine.
